What goes on in class?

READING AND WRITING

 - pronouns

ORAL COMMUNICATION

- Show-and-tell presentations
- Share-and-inquire discussions (e.g. what is the difference between fruit and vegetables?)

● WRITE ON!

We get your child interested in writing by inquiring into children's books, learning best writing techniques and how to emulate them

● RAISING READERS

We incorporate phonics, songs and rhymes into our lessons, building a strong foundation and an interest in reading

● BE HEARD

Our lessons encourage our children to be active listeners and articulate speakers, developing their own voice and perspective

● BE CURIOUS

Our students are exposed to a wide range of themes (e.g. biodiversity, young game changers) to get them to think beyond the classroom academia

● BE INFORMED

After each lesson, parents receive a summary of what was covered in class, as well as suggested activities to reinforce learning at home
